Red Cross is providing direct financial assistance to households impacted by flooding in Ontario and Quebec. Eligible households will receive \$600. The Government of Ontario, Ministry of Municipal Affairs and the Ministry of Housing, is access to the Disaster Recovery Assistance for Ontarians Program. This program is designed to help people affected by natural disasters get back on their feet. After a natural disaster, people may need help to cover the costs of cleaning, repairing and replacing essential property, so their lives can get back to normal. Disaster Recovery Assistance for Ontarians provides financial assistance to individuals, small owner-operated businesses, farmers and not-for-profit organizations. It helps cover emergency expenses, repairs, or replacement of essential property after a natural disaster. Affected residents should save any receipts and document their time in protecting their personal homes as they may be eligible to apply for financial assistance through the Province.
